

Digigraph Principles

Introduction

The Digigraph Principles are found in the Aurum Verses. We will provide a full, detailed discussion when we have the time. Here are the first two principles. Note, also, that these are the first two principles of Manuscript Hermeneutics.

Freedom Principle

Aurum Verse

2 Timothy 2:9 (Aurum Clause [see [Advanced Aurum Verses Bible](#)]): ...**the word of God is not bound.**

General

God's word is never suppressed.

Special (Specific)

The text collected first is the correct text.

One application of the special form of the freedom principle is that the Alexandrian manuscripts, being collected later, are not the correct text in a number of places.

Constancy Principle

Aurum Verse

1 Peter 1:25: But **the word of the Lord endureth for ever.** And this is the word which by the gospel is preached unto you.

General

God's word doesn't change.

Special (Specific)

A text collected later that contradicts the text collected first is incorrect.

One application of this principle is that the Alexandrian manuscripts are incorrect in a number of places.
